

Catch-Up Premium 2016/2017

Number of eligible students	98
Catch-up Premium Funding	£24,000

- Funding is used to substantially fund a fulltime Literacy Mentor and a fulltime Numeracy Mentor
- Students are identified as requiring intervention if they have a Age Related Expectation (ARE) below 100 when they enter the Academy in year 7.
- Intervention is planned depending on the needs of the individual students and delivered by either 1:1 support (in and out of the classroom) or small group work.
- Learning mentors will work closely with the English and Mathematics teachers to ensure that the intervention delivered supports what is being learned within the classroom.
- Learning mentors will also work on improving student confidence in English and Mathematics as well as across all subjects and learning.
