Dear Parents/Carers

We made it! Change of name

Onsite Testing

We are expecting to test all students twice on their return after the summer break. We will be sending out information soon confirming when your child needs to come onsite for their first test starting on 31 August. Please ensure you have completed the consent form. Any students who have tested positive since 1 June will not be able to have this test due to NHS guidance on not testing within 90 days of a positive result. The second tests will take place week beginning 6 September during the school day. You should then continue to test twice a week at home until the end of September.

Covid systems

It is anticipated that we won't have to operate in quite the restricted way we have had to this year, however there will be a few things we will keep in place. Hair and Nails

Gel and acrylic nails are permitted but they must be short and of a neutral colour. Students who have nails which are too long, will be asked to get them cut. Please support us with this at the end of the summer break by getting any "summer nails" cut to a suitable length (or removed) ready for the start of term. Hair should not be dyed a bright "unnatural" colour for example blue or purple. Whilst students can colour their hair, it should not be an extreme colour. Any student returning in September with an extreme hair colour will be placed in isolation until it can be rectified.

PE kit

Thank you for your responses to our survey on PE kit. 95% of you stated that you preferred your child to come to school in their kit on the days they have PE and Dance. This supports the student and staff voice which were equally as positive. Therefore, we will maintain the system of students coming into school in their kit. However, this **must be** the official kit as per our policy:-

Reminder about Return dates

Class of 2026/Year 7 will be in on Thursday 2 and Friday 3 September 2021 for their induction to the academy.

Year 12 will start on Thursday 2 and Year 13 will join them on Friday 3 September 2021. All students will be in from Monday 6 September 2021.

All students are to return in full Academy uniform on their first day when they will receive their timetables. They will then know which days to attend in their PE/Dance kits.
