
As you have already provisionally chosen your options for Year 12, the Sixth Form Team are currently putting together packs of bridging activities and transition work that you can be working on independently during this time away from school. The tasks are set to introduce to you to the subjects you have chosen and allow you complete some wider reading around the subject so that when you start in September you already have an understanding of the subject.

As soon as the packs have been put together they will be uploaded to the Skegness Academy website within the Sixth Form area but we will send out a link when they are ready to be accessed, which is likely to be after Easter. You will be required to complete the work set for the options you have chosen prior to starting in the Sixth Form in September.

Further information will come out soon but I wanted to keep you updated with what is going on behind the scenes to ensure that your education is not disadvantaged by the current situation.
