Dear Parent/Carer

As you may be aware, the National Education Union (NEU) have confirmed that its members will be striking over pay on two more days at the end of this month and at the beginning of May. I am writing to reassure you about what this means and how it will impact your child.

Currently, strikes that will impact our academy are scheduled to take place on the below dates:

- Thursday 27 April 2023
- Tuesday 2 May 2023

Striking is the right of every teacher who is part of a union and is a personal choice which we respect as an academy and Trust. As the academy's Principal, the safety and wellbeing of our students is my top priority. As we have a high proportion of academy staff who are members of the NEU, there will not be enough staff for us to safely welcome all students on site, making it challenging for us to keep the academy fully open on strike days.

As a consequence, for the next two days of industrial action on Thursday 27 April and Tuesday 2 May 2023, the academy will only be open for the groups below:

Thursday 27 April 2023 – Normal School Hours

- Students in year 10
- Students in year 11
- Students in year 12
- Students in year 13
- Students who are classed as vulnerable
- Students whose parents are classed as critical workers (please see below)

Tuesday 2 May 2023 – Normal School Hours

- Students in year 10
- Students in year 11
- Students in year 12
- Students in year 13
- Students who are classed as vulnerable
- Students whose parents are classed as critical workers and wish their child to attend on 27 April and 2 May should complete the following form by clicking here. The form will close on Wednesday 26 April 2023 at 12.00 pm.

The above arrangements will be confirmed in a further letter which will be sent to parents on Monday 24 April 2023

Sadly, on this occasion, we will be closed to anyone who does not receive a direct invitation to attend.

I am sorry that this is the case, but I am sure you understand that the industrial action relates to important education funding issues nationally – rather than anything at a school or local level.

We will continue to communicate with you and keep you updated on the arrangements or any changes to the planned strike action.

Early next week, I will also send out details of online resources your children should complete at home when they are unable to attend school.
