Dear Parent/Carer

We are writing to you about the exciting Sixth Form Charity Week in aid of Prostate Cancer UK, which will be held in the last week of this term running from Monday 25 March 2024 to Thursday 28 March 2024.

The activities that the Sixth Form students will be running are as follows -

- Monday 25 March Staff members who have volunteered will go 'into the stocks' during the lunch period and students will pay to throw wet sponges at them!
- Tuesday 26 March Cake Sale cakes and biscuits baked by the Sixth Form students and staff will be on sale in the Bistro.
- Wednesday 27 March There will be a Colour Fun Run around the school field, students will need to run or walk 2 miles of the field (6 laps), and this will be a sponsored event.
