Project Title- “Change”

Scenario

The covid-19 pandemic has brought about unprecedented pain, hurt and suffering to many people across the world. The work you create should be personal to you and explore the materials, techniques and processes that you feel you work best with.



As part of your project

- ▶ Start by generating ideas using a mind-map or mood board.
- ▶ Draw, draw and draw from observation (the more you practice the better you will get).
- ▶ Find artists that interest you and analyse their work (avoid copying what they have done as this is pointless, instead look at their work and note down the key things you notice)
- ▶ Explore materials, techniques and processes like your artist and based on your own ideas (experiment in different sizes and different ways).
- ▶ Create ideas for a final piece.
- ▶ Produce a final piece

I appreciate that some of these steps may prove difficult but there is no expectation of size, scale or breadth of your work at this point. What is important is that you follow a process from start to finish and create a piece inspired by the theme.
