RE: Practical lessons and uniform expectations

As you are aware, in order to adhere to current guidance, when your child has their Physical Education or Dance/Performing Arts lessons, they must come to the Academy in their PE kit.

I just wanted to remind students and parents the expectations regarding the PE kit.

On the day your child has PE, they must attend in full Skegness Academy PE kit, which consists of

- Skegness Academy PE t-shirt
- **Black** tracksuit bottoms, shorts or sports leggings.
- Trainers.

If your child would like to wear a jacket/jumper, this must either be the plain black Skegness Academy hoodie or a plain black hoodie or jumper.

The above items are available at the nationwide uniform suppliers.

On the day your child has Dance or Performing Arts they should come dressed in their dance t-shirts if they are Key Stage 4 or Key Stage 5 but if they are in Key Stage 3 then they come in their PE t-shirts.

If you require financial support towards the cost of uniform or PE kit please email the Principal, Mr Johnson on johnson@skegnessacademy.org, who may be able to approve you for some help towards the cost of the uniform required.

The whole Academy uniform policy will be applied for students who do not attend in PE kit or attend in incorrect kit on their PE day.

Finally, can I reiterate the importance of pupils only coming in PE kit or Dance/Performing Art kit on their designated days. Pupils who come in PE or Dance/Performing Arts kit on non-PE days will be challenged by staff.
