- **Tuesday 1 April** - Cake Sale – cakes and biscuits baked by the Sixth Form students and staff will be on sale in the Bistro at break and lunch time.
- **Wednesday 2 April** – Easter Raffle an exciting selection of prizes, including generous donations from local businesses, Easter eggs, and much more—be sure to take part in our raffle for a chance to win!
