

CURRICULUM ROADMAP

Year 10 - Tutor

Term 6 – Misogyny and Incel Behaviour

In this final term, students will understand how harmful stereotypes between men and women can cause misogynistic behaviours and who that impacts most. They will understand how historically women have been treated and see examples of Incel behaviour and the harmful behaviours that women experience.

Term 5 – Unhealthy Relationships

Term 5 highlights some common warning signs of unhealthy relationships, which will include controlling behaviours and types of abuse within a romantic relationship. It breaks down physical, emotional and economic abuse and the signs that someone might be experiencing this and where to seek support.

Term 4 – Community Behaviour

During this term, students will start to reflect on their behaviour whilst out in the community, including how to be respectful towards residents in the local community. They will look into antisocial behaviours and the law aspect of that, which involves how their behaviour choices can have consequences.

Term 3 – Mental Health

Students will learn the different types of mental health conditions and the warning signs to look out for within themselves and others. They will understand how to seek support if they feel their mental health is impacted and also what factors could cause a mental health condition. They will also understand how to recognise certain emotions and how they impact our mental health, such as high stress levels.

Term 2 – Online Safety

Term 2 will see students developing their understanding of online dangers. They will develop key skills to understand how to protect their data and how their digital footprint can impact their futures. They will also look into Deepfakes and AI, recognising how misinformation can be harmful and create negative viewpoints on ourselves and society.

Term 1 – Substance Abuse

Students will start by understanding different types of substances and the dangers that come with them. They will learn about the different types of legal and illegal drugs and the impact they have on the body, as well as what damage vaping and alcohol use does. They will also look into the reasons people start abusing substances, such as peer pressure and lifestyles.
