Term 5 – Intervention/Exams

Term 4 – Substance Use

Students will explore the misconceptions around party drugs, as well as their effects and risks. They'll learn to identify several myths around party drugs, including their prevalence, and safety. We will explore the definition, symptoms and development of alcohol dependence. We begin by understanding the role alcohol plays in society, and how its social acceptance means it should be treated carefully..

Term 3 – Financial Literacy

In this term, students will explore what public money is, how it's raised through taxes, and what governments spend it on. Students will explore the concepts of credit and debt, understanding how borrowing decisions impact financial stability. They will learn to distinguish between manageable debt and financial difficulty.

Term 2 – Sexual Health

In this term, we explore the nature of safe relationships online. We explore the behaviour standards for people online, as well as their rights and responsibilities. Students will explore the various considerations involved in selecting suitable contraception methods. We will address the important and sensitive topic of sexual violence and abuse, exploring its definition, impact, and the crucial role of consent..

Term 1 – Diversity and Culture

Students will explore the complexities of stereotyping across gender, race and religion, sexual orientation, and disability. By examining real-life case studies, students will engage in thoughtful analysis of the individual and societal impacts of stereotypes and understand how to be respectful of protected characteristics.
