RE: Final contribution of Household Support Fund

Since March 2020, the Government have supported families of school aged children with the cost of meals while schools were temporary or partially closed during the COVID-19 pandemic. As we continue to navigate out of the pandemic, Lincolnshire County Council will be providing each child who qualifies for Free School Meals a final voucher for £95. Each voucher per eligible child will be sent in the usual way via text message before the Academy closes for the May Half Term break on Friday 27 May 2022. Please can I take the opportunity to remind you of your responsibility to keep the Academy up to date with your contact details, especially mobile phone number.

To be eligible, only families recorded as eligible for Free School Meals on Tuesday 10 May 2022 will qualify for this voucher per eligible child. This one-off payment provides a final opportunity to provide support to eligible families.

We are aware that the past two years have been challenging for families in a variety of different ways. However, there are still community support groups available if you find yourself in need of additional support. The Skegness Food Bank is located at the Storehouse (North Parade, Skegness, PE25 1BY) and provides 3 days emergency food for local people in financial hardship. It is open Monday to Friday between 10.00am and 12.00pm.
